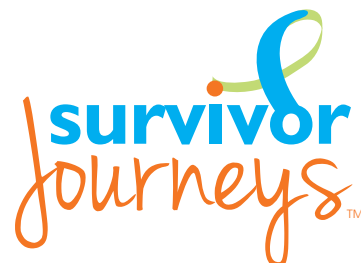
Surviving cancer involves more than the treatment prescribed. Sometimes there is little focus on the other aspects of a survivor's life during care and beyond.
